PROTECTIVE CONCEALMENT

1. General

This course of instruction is for the purpose of familiarizing members of the Civil Air Patrol with practical measures for the concealment of important civilian installations and equipment from aerial observation.

2. Text

The War Department has prepared for the Office of Civilian Defense a special textbook entitled "Protective Concealment", which has been adopted as the Civil Air Patrol text for this course.

3. Distribution

Copies of this Directive and Text will be distributed on the basis of four copies per Headquarters.


4. Requirement

All Civil Air Patrol members are required to take this course.

5. Instruction Procedure

There will be two classroom instruction periods of one hour each devoted to the fundamentals of Protective Concealment as presented in the text. These periods will include lectures, general discussion, and questions covering this subject. It is suggested that where possible the services of Army Engineer Officers (either active or retired) be enlisted as instructors in this course.
