

PARTS, EQUIPMENT, AND MAINTENANCE FOR AAF AIRCRAFT
ASSIGNED TO CIVIL AIR PATROL

1. This memorandum is in response to inquiries received from Wing Commanders with reference to an announcement made by the Air Service Command Liaison Officer relative above subject at the conference of Wing Commanders held at this Headquarters on 27 and 28 April 1944.

2. Authority TWX Teletype ASCSP5-3-28, Headquarters, Air Service Command, 20 March 1944, copy of which is attached hereto, and pending revision of AAF Regulation No. 65-63, which revision is expected to be published in the near future, the Air Service Command, through its Control Depots, will provide all parts and equipment, contingent on availability, and perform such maintenance as comes within the provisions of AAF Regulation No. 20-31 (third and fourth echelon maintenance) for all AAF aircraft assigned to Civil Air Patrol.
