

SUMMARY

Chapter One: NARRATIVE

This chapter provides a written account of the activities of the different staff functions and some of the events of 1990. Footnotes are provided to indicate sources of information.

Page One: Information on the Wing Commander, and location of Texas Wing Headquarters. Also included on this page is information on membership, number of units, personnel and safety.

Page Two: Information on the Cadet program, senior member training, emergency services, customs activities, administration and inspections.

Chapter Two: Report on Customs Activities by Lt. Col. W.P. Yeates

Pages four and five: Statistics, problems and highlights of the 1990 customs effort.

Pages six through ten: A chronology of noteworthy sightings made by Texas Wing aircrews for the period of June through October, 1990.

This history of the Texas Wing, Civil Air Patrol, covers the time period of 1 January 1990 through 31 December 1990.

During 1990, Texas Wing was commanded by Colonel George H. ("Hal") Parker. Headquarters continued to be located at Bergstrom Air Force Base near Austin, Texas.

**MEMBERSHIP:** As of 31 December 1990, there were 1,651 senior members which was a net loss of 17 from the same time in 1989. There were 1,105 Cadets compared to 1,102 twelve months before.

As of 31 December 1990, Texas Wing was organized into 14 Groups, 67 squadrons and no flights.

**PERSONNEL:** During 1990 the following personnel actions were processed:

312	form 2's
704	form 2A's

74	form 24's
63	form 27's
79	form 120's

The members that were 2B'ed were done at the members request rather than dismissal for cause. There were no demotions for cause during the year.

According to the wing personnel officer, some group and squadron commanders did not appear to be delegating the personnel function to the unit personnel officer. This activity made it difficult for the unit personnel officer to maintain proper records.

Also according to the wing personnel officer, there had been much improvement in the forms being properly completed when being forwarded to the Wing Personnel Office. Because of the proper documented form, the time for completion of the requested action had been reduced. The reduced action completion time, and the hard work by the wing personnel staff resulted in an "Outstanding", rating from the Air Force inspection team visit in November, 1990. 1

**SAFETY:** During 1990, Texas Wing suffered no aircraft accidents and no loss of life for any operational cause. There were three aircraft incidents, one vehicle accident and one injury. Capt. Harry Phillips of 4th Group was named Safety Officer of the year. 2

**CADET PROGRAM:** During calendar year 1990, 129 Texas Wing Cadets attended encampments. There were 46 Mitchell Awards, 21 Earhart Awards and 2 Spaatz Awards during the year. Names of Cadets who received the top three Cadet awards, are listed in appendix four.<sup>3 & 4</sup>

**SENIOR MEMBER TRAINING:** During 1990, 1263 senior members completed Level One training. Four seniors attended National Staff College and 23 attended Southwest Region Staff College. The only area Texas Wing did not reach 100% of its goal was attendance at Region Staff College, which had a requirement of 34 personnel to attend.

Texas Wing only had 4 personnel to earn the Yeager Aerospace Award for all of 1990. <sup>4</sup>

**EMERGENCY SERVICES:** During calendar year 1990, Texas Wing participated in 193 missions. These missions required the use of 225 aircraft flying 409 sorties for a total of 768.8 hours. This emergency services effort also required 1796 personnel to expend 1619.7 total man-days on missions.<sup>5</sup>

**AEROSPACE EDUCATION:** A.E. continues to be the weakest link in the chain of Civil Air Patrol missions performed by Texas Wing. As noted above, only 4 senior member personnel completed the Aerospace Education Program for Senior Members during 1990. The wing historian sent a formal request to the wing Director of Aerospace Education in March 1991 to collect more data on this area. As of 27 May 1991, no reply has been received. This leads to the assumption that there was nothing to report.

**CUSTOMS ACTIVITIES:** This recent mission task has become one of the most important in Texas Wing during the last two or three years. The wing expended over 8000 man-hours on customs activities during 1990.

The coordinator for customs activities for Texas Wing, is Lt. Col. William P. Yeates. His annual report to the commander, is included in its entirety as chapter two of this narrative.

**CHAPTER TWO, 1990 CUSTOMS ACTIVITIES**

## Texas Wing CAP/US Customs Activities 1990

Total number of missions: 673

Total number of hours flown: 2620 of which 532 were marine patrol  
and 2088 various land missions.

Total missions expenses: \$ 123,745.34

Estimated man hours: 8000

Number of qualified personnel: 390

One training seminar was held with 133 Texas personnel attending.

Types of missions included:

- Coastwatch - continuous patrols from Brownsville, Victoria, and Beaumont. A Cessna 182RG was based in Houston in August and began marine patrols from there. More than 3000 marine vessels were identified during the year.
- Landmark - a program to cover all 1200 grids in Texas to document uncharted airstrips. This program was completed in August after locating over 1800 uncharted airstrips.
- Borderwatch - began in February. Frequent flights along the entire 1200 mile border.
- Transportation- transportation assistance was provided USCS for agents and materials throughout the year.
- Radar Evaluation - two kinds of missions were flown. One was for evaluating the Customs fixed aerostats on the border. The other was a joint Customs/Norad mission where CAP flew into Mexico (with Mex. permission) and re-entered the US as an unidentified aircraft. Five missions of this type were flown with only one being detected.

The number of drug seizures made as a direct result of CAP involvement is unknown as that kind of information rarely comes back to us. However, there were apparently some spotted by CAP aircrews. Some of these are mentioned in the list of highlights released by Customs (enclosed).

#### Problems

1. There were several occurrences of CAP aircraft being intercepted by Customs or Coast Guard aircraft, although the CAP flight schedule was supposedly sent to all the Customs Air Branches and Coast Guard air stations. The problem lessened as they became more aware of the presence of CAP and we became more aware of the common radio frequencies.

2. The requested number of border flights was a problem in itself. We were asked to fly the entire border twice daily, at dawn and dusk. We divided the border into 5 sections:

Each section is more than 200 miles and is just about the limit for Cessna 172's considering the lack of refueling places. Thus we would require 10 flights a day or 300 a month. But there are only two CAP units on the border: Brownsville and El Paso. In between, there is one unit 80 miles from the river and another 100 miles from the river. All others are 200 or more miles away. There were enough CAP members who were willing to spend two or more days on the border at their own expense, that we began assigning overnight missions with the requirement that at least two border flights be made. By doing this, we could justify as cost effective the flying of several hundred miles just to reach the border.

3. A problem that still has not been resolved is the lack of compatible radios with Customs. Three of the aircraft on marine patrol have Customs radios that are quite effective, but only two others that regularly fly the border have the radios. The rest must land and report any sightings by telephone. This lack of communications has probably hampered the seizure of some of the suspicious sightings that CAP has made.

#### Highlights

Texas CAP personnel participated in the evaluation of an Australian Nomad aircraft in June. This was a twin turboprop equipped with radar and FLIR and was designed especially for marine patrols. Besides evaluating the aircraft, Customs wanted to see what kind of traffic occurs beyond the 25 miles that CAP patrols out to 150 miles. CAP crews from Groups 11 and 13 briefed the Nomad crew on the types of vessels encountered within 25 miles. Then CAP personnel were flown as observers on 9 of the evaluation flights.

I am enclosing a list of CAP sightings released by Customs. Some of these were by Arizona Wing so you can edit those out if you use it. It gives a good idea of the effectiveness of the border flights.

I would also like to add one other incident in which a CAP marine patrol aircraft aided a sailboat in distress. On Dec 8 1990, Maj. William Burton and Cpt. Ron Johnston were patrolling offshore near South Padre Island. They spotted a distress flare from a sailboat which was disabled and drifting toward the beach. After calling the Coast Guard, the CAP crew stayed with the boat until help arrived. The boat was found to have a broken rudder and would have been wrecked on the beach.

#### CIVIL AIR PATROL

The following describes noteworthy Texas and Arizona Wing sightings which occurred during the period June - October, 1990.

#### Events of Interest

- June 1 - CAP reported to Sector the sighting of a truck and four boats meeting at the river's edge 20 miles west of Presidio, Tx.
- June 5 - Two pickup trucks met on opposite sides of the river south of Porvenir, Tx.
- June 7 - Three persons were seen attempting to cross the river five miles southeast of Eagle Pass, Texas.
- June 8 - Six persons were seen crossing the river five miles west of Rio Grande Village, Tx. Five carried clothing. One person who was carrying a package ran for cover when the CAP a/c flew by.
- June 14 - A fishing boat traveling upriver near Dryden, Texas speeded up and entered some reeds growing along the bank when circled by a CAP a/c.
- June 18 - An aircraft was sighted on the ground at an unmarked airstrip along the river 3 miles south of Heath Canyon.
- July 1 - On the river across from Apache Ranch, Tx, a boat was sighted with sacks tied to the Mexican side of the vessel. Also seen were sacks lying in brush close to the boat.
- July 8 - The U.S. Border Patrol was notified of eight persons sighted attempting to cross the river south of Eagle Pass, Tx.
- July 14 - A vehicle was observed crossing the border and proceeding north near San Miguel, Az.
- July 14 - A Texas Wing pilot reported seeing a possible marijuana field near 3032N/10454W.

- July 19 - Two men on horseback were seen crossing the river into the United States four miles downriver from Lajitas, Texas.
- July 23 - Two cars were spotted parked on the Rancho Granja airstrip three miles west of Lukeville, Az. At the same time, a car was seen moving slowly toward the airstrip from on a dirt road in the hills across the border from the airstrip. The cars on the airstrip left the area as the CAP a/c began to circle overhead.
- July 24 - Small rectangular patches have been cleared from the field suspected of being used to raise marijuana. (See 7/14 entry.)
- July 25 - CAP observed persons unloading boxes at the border in Az. from a Bronco to a Van. When the CAP a/c approached, the people jumped into their vehicles and rapidly departed the area going in different directions.
- August 4 - CAP observed a pickup north of the Mx/Az border and another pickup in the brush about 250 feet south of the border. On a return flight an hour later, a van was seen crossing the border at the same location heading north. Another three pickup trucks were seen south of the border about 3/4 of a mile away.
- August 5 - Near Sells, Arizona, CAP at 31.33.30N/111.46W sighted five vehicles which had apparently just crossed the border. CAP pilots witnessed a pickup crossing the border with several bundles in back. As the CAP a/c circled overhead, the rest of the people entered their vehicles quickly retreated into Mexico, abandoning a station wagon which had become stuck in the sand.
- August 11 - Sector was notified of the sighting of 3 vehicles (1 truck, 1 auto and 1 motorcycle) crossing the Arizona border at 31.32N/111.45W, near Newfield Cut.
- August 16 - A helicopter, possibly a Bell 500, was observed flying very low to the ground along the border approximately 5 miles west of Horse Peak near Rancho El Represito, Az. The same helicopter was seen later on the ground at Lukeville, Az.
- August 16 - Numerous vehicles, men on horseback and several small boats were sighted grouped in Mexico along

the banks of the river about one mile east of San Vincente, Tx. Two or three persons were seen transferring boxes between the bank and a boat.

- August 17 - CAP sighted a flatbed dumptruck and three persons in the dry riverbed about 100 feet south of the border at 110.31.20W. About two hours later, the dumptruck was seen moving eastward in the U.S. on a dirt road toward Naco, Az.
- August 18 - On a sharp bend of the river on the Mexico side, two miles east of El Capote, Mx a red flatbed truck loaded with brown bags was sighted parked on a sandy area of the bank. Two men stood nearby with an extended length of rope. Sector was notified and a USBP unit arrived on the U.S. side and stood watch.
- August 18 - A car with its trunk open was observed parked in Mexico near the river. Two individuals behaved suspiciously, apparently hiding in the reeds on the U.S. side, as the CAP a/c flew overhead. As the a/c departed, the individuals were seen returning to the Mexican side of the river.
- August 19 - A pickup truck was observed crossing through the border fence into the U.S. at the gate just west of Lochiel, Arizona.
- August 19 - Several persons were sighted standing near vehicles parked together. Two pickups were seen crossing the border through San Miguel Gate, Az.
- August 21 - Sector was notified of two trucks parked just north of the Arizona border.
- Sept. 2 - CAP sighted two light pick-ups with camper-shells parked at the Hot Springs, Tx. airstrip. Six cube-like packages were lying on the ground next to the vehicles.
- Sept. 10 - Electronics parts were delivered to the Customs Office, Marfa, Texas.
- Sept. 13 - A vehicle was spotted apparently hidden beneath trees near an abandoned adobe ranch building located "a few feet" north of the border fence 10 miles east of San Miguel, Az. (More conveniently situated shade trees to park under were seen nearby. No persons were observed.)

- Sept. 17 - A dump truck was sighted parked in a dry wash about 100 yards south of the border in Mexico, ten miles west of Bisbee, Az. At the same time, a vehicle parked on the U.S. side of the border rapidly departed the area when the CAP aircraft circled overhead.
- Sept. 17 - A group of approximately 20 men and women carrying bags/bundles were seen assembled on a concrete ramp at some sort of pumping station on the border in the Brownsville, Tx area.
- Sept. 18 - CAP reported several places along the Arizona border where the border fence was down.
- Sept. 24 - A new dirt airstrip was located 7 miles west of Heath Canyon on the U.S. side of the border.
- Sept. 25 - Sector was advised that one mile east of the Roma bridge two vehicles were sighted on opposite sides of the river. Persons on the Mexican side were looking across the river. An agent at the Roma, POE responded, but was unable to locate the vehicles.
- Sept. 27 - A possible new dirt landing strip was observed on a hillside in the area of Presidio, Tx.
- Sept. 27 - An unusual meeting between private and commercial fishing vessels was observed. Two shrimping vessels were spotted tied to sports fishing vessels and two other shrimpers were seen being approached by sport fishers.
- Sept. 28 - An uncharted grass strip with an adjacent gravel road was spotted near Indio, Tx.
- Sept. 28 - Four persons and a Chevy Suburban were seen waiting at the border gate, on the U.S. side, three miles southeast of Duquesne, Az. The vehicle rapidly departed the area following the CAP fly-by.
- Sept. 28 - A dirt airstrip was spotted on the south side of the border near Ejido Emilio Carranza, Mx across from Indio, Tx.
- Sept. 29 - Sector was notified of an aircraft parked on a dirt airstrip in an isolated stretch of highway east of the Whetstone Mts, Az.

- Sept. 29 - A white bus was sighted parked for several hours on the Mexican side of the border fence nine miles west of Lukeville, Az.
- Oct. 5 - TX CAP advised that two people were seen crossing the river and hiding in the bushes when flown over. Two pickups on opposite sides of the river at 28.47.5N/100.26.6W. Sector advised a Special Agent who contacted the CAP flight directly.
- Oct. 28 - An Operation Coastwatch mission reported to the U.S. Coast Guard the sighting of 3 large sport fishing vessels tied to an oil rig on which a helicopter rested. When the CAP aircraft returned a few minutes later, all of the vessels had departed the area. The rig is located about 10 miles offshore from Port Mansfield, Tx.
- Oct. 31 - CAP observed 15 to 20 aliens attempting to cross the river in small groups from 1 mile upriver to 5 miles downriver from the Eagle Pass, Texas Port of Entry. None were reported to be carrying large bundles.

During this same time period, information on several hundred vessel sightings was collected. Vessel sightings data is studied by an intelligence analyst during efforts to track the movements of vessels suspected of being narcotic smuggling platforms.

2. ADMINISTRATION: (OUTSTANDING)

a. The administrative function was providing superb service in support of the unit mission. The publications and forms management system was aggressively maintained. Proper controls to ensure maximum efforts were made to conserve publications and forms were provided. CAP publications indexes were accurately posted indicating publications on-hand. The blank forms were neatly filed which aided all wing staff in acquiring reference forms. Though not documented, these areas were inventoried twice a year to ensure currency. A solid suspense system was established. This was used to manage incoming and outgoing correspondence which required action to be completed by a particular date. This suspense system was also used as a reference point for all wing directors and the wing commander. The lockbox container used to store accounting and finance mail ensured the utmost protection. Implementation and management of this program far exceeded requirements.

b. (Noteworthy) The use of a postal meter greatly enhanced expediting all mailouts.

c. (Noteworthy) Monthly phone costs were kept at a minimum due to the director's ability to become proficient in the use of the wing's radio system which enabled her to exchange information with individuals out in the field.

d. OBSERVATION: Ensure wing supplements do not repeat policy already stated in a CAP regulation, and emphasis on timely annual reviews of wing supplements and forms was warranted.

SUBJECT: OVERWATER ORIENTATION

The second Texas Wing water survival/over-water orientation training mission will be conducted at N.A.S. Corpus Christi and Corpus Christi International Airport on 27-29 July 1990. This will be a funded mission, however, the flying hours are limited by USAF budgets this year, thus the attendance is limited.

The water survival training and all briefing for the over-water flying will be held at the U.S. Naval Hospital (Bldg. H-100) on Saturday, 28 July, and will start promptly at 0745 hours. The training will be conducted by Navy personnel from the Aviation Physiology Training Unit (APTU). This training must be attended in order to participate in the over-water flying on Sunday, 29 July. Members who wish to participate in the swim program must have a Class III FAA medical, or higher, and should know how to swim. The swimming portion of this exercise will consist of a 50 yard qualification swim, 5 minutes of water treading, and 10 minutes of drown proofing. Non-swimmers and members without Class III medicals will remain in the shallow water to do their raft boarding. The water treading, drown proofing, and the raft boarding will be done in normal flight gear and tennis shoes. The APTU will furnish the flight suits. Members shall bring their own swim wear, tennis shoes, and towels for the pool activities.

Due to space availability in the training facility, this exercise will be limited to 100 applicants. The BOQ billeting facility is providing 50 rooms (double twin beds and single double beds) on a first come first served basis. Members are encouraged to double up. Members without BOQ billeting must understand that motel accommodations ~~may~~ <sup>will</sup> be ~~their~~ <sup>your</sup> own responsibility.

Application for the water survival/over-water flying mission must be by Form 17. Indicate in the remarks section of Form 17 whether you desire BOQ billeting (\$8.00/person/night), Saturday breakfast and lunch (normal charge), if you are flying in, estimated time enroute, FAA medical, instrument rating, and if you are a swimmer. Applications (Form 17) shall be mailed directly to the Wing Coordinator, MAJ. R.W. Edwards, 2504 Huntwick Dr. #808, Austin TX, 78741. Questions of a local nature may be directed to the Project Officer, 1LT Mucio Garza, at (512) 854-2326. Please attach a copy of your latest Form 5 and FAA Medical.

Applications shall be postmarked by 9 June, 1990. Priority will be given to those who did not attend the first coastal SAR in 1988 followed by applicants from coastal groups. Only corporate aircraft will participate on the over-water flying. Each flight crew will consist of two pilots and one or two observers. One of the two pilots must be instrument rated. Crews will be selected by the flight operations officer with approval of the senior mission coordinator. Details will be in the supplement to the generic order to follow. Notification of selection to attend will be by mail no later than 14 July.

The second SAR exercise of 1990 will be held on June 22-23, 1990 at two locations. The West Texas mission base will be located at Ft. Stockton, Texas, (FST). Major Jim Barber will serve as project officer. The East Texas mission base will be located at Lufkin, Texas, (LFK). Major Ed Graham will serve as project officer.

Our goals for this exercise are as follows:

- 1.) Develop a functioning, professional quality mission team for search and rescue, located in the far west area of Texas Wing.
- 2.) Offer actual mission experience (simulated) for a select team of prospective mission team members.
- 3.) Offer training and requalification opportunities for prequalified mission pilots and their crew members.
- 4.) Offer training and requalification opportunities for prequalified mission ground teams.

The procedure for this exercise will require that two staff groups be set up to plan and execute the project. The two groups are as follows:


- 1.) **Training Staff-** will plan the two hours of classroom type training to be accomplished from 08:30 to 10:30 for Air Crews and Ground Crews. This staff will also plan the scenario for the mission, and act as witnesses, family, press, etc. during the exercise.
- 2.) **Mission Staff-** will plan the mission headquarters layout, set up the operations areas, and execute the (simulated) mission as presented by the Training Staff.

To participate in the mission, on an air crew, ground team, or on the mission staff, members shall submit a CAP 17. The form shall include the following information in addition to the blanks listed on the form. Applicants shall list qualifications, FAA, CAP, etc. for the job requested. Air crews shall list aircraft to be used and other aircrew members. (Attach CAP 17 for each crew member). No aircrew will be approved without at least one, (prefer more), observer and/or copilot, as weight, balance, and density altitude will allow. Each form shall be approved and signed by the unit commander of the member(s). Crew members may be pilot or observer trainee if primary applicant if fully mission qualified.

All CAP 17's shall be submitted to Texas Wing Headquarters for processing. Acceptance letters will be sent to each member approved to participate at least two weeks before the exercise. Selections will be based of first come first serve basis. It is hoped that all who wish to participate will be able to be accommodated. A hotel list will be sent with each acceptance letter.

Any suggestions for improving the exercise will be appreciated and will be given prompt consideration. Your assistance in making this one of the best ever training exercises is greatly appreciated.





The Velcro used under the outer garment epaulet to hold the new circlets may become detached during dry cleaning. It should be removed or replaced. The sew-on Velcro for replacement will be furnished by the Bookstore at no cost.

OPERATIONS: All pilots should be aware of the new CAPR 900-4. Check pilots. your attention is called to the new CAPF 91. Mission Pilot Checkout.

SAFETY: A reminder that Safety meeting reports are due on a monthly basis. There have been three minor incidents so we will not make our Zero In 90 but you are doing a great job out there so keep up the good work. A Safety officer is never out of a job.

ADMINISTRATION: Charts are enclosed for the new reimbursement schedule that started 15 OCT. An error was found on the category chart sent earlier. The T41 listed in category III should be the 210 HP engine. Many of you are still sending copies of aircraft fuel tickets. We do not need them. We do need three copies of auto fuel tickets and a CAPF 109. REPEAT: CAPF 108 is due at Wing Ho. within 15 days of close of the mission.

The LO office now has a Data Fax unit. It will be available 24 hours a day. The number is 512-369-3694.

For those of you interested in the Wing Inspection--we received an overall score of Excellent. Five of the directorates were rated Outstanding.

Several Wing officers need rosters of their counterparts in subordinate units. We are asking Group, Commanders to collect this information from their Squadrons and forward it to Wing with their Headquarters lists. A CAPF 2a is required by regulation for Support Officers. A copy is enclosed for local reproduction. This must be processed whenever there is a change. If no one is assigned the UNIT Commander should sign.

The other Officers needed are Safety, PAO-Unit and Mission qualified. AE. and ES. A current alert roster is also needed from each unit. Wing should be notified whenever changes occur in these assignments.

If there is any urgent business to transact please do so prior to Thanksgiving week. Headquarters may be closed that week but will be on Thursday and Friday.


