



HONOR AWARDS

The "HONOR SQUADRON" is relatively new to Ohio Wing, CIVIL AIR PATROL. Prior to the 1958 Summer Encampment, at the recommendation of the OHIO WING CADET ADVISORY COUNCIL, Col. Lyle Castle, Wing commander, Authorized the daily selection of an "HONOR SQUADRON" and the selection of a squadron to carry the title of "ENCAMPMENT HONOR SQUADRON" at the completion of the encampment period. This selection is based on the general appearance of the barracks, effectiveness of squadron staff, and general conduct of cadets. Grading is accomplished by the CADET GROUP INSPECTION TEAM.

Each day the "HONOR SQUADRON'S " guidon is adorned with the streamer that bears the colors of the encampment ribbon. This streamer will be presented to the commander of the "ENCAMPMENT HONOR SQUADRON" as a memento of the encampment. In addition each member of the "HONOR SQUADRON" will have their Certificate of Accomplishment, bear the mark of "HONOR SQUADRON" and will be presented with a pen that will have an inscription stating that they were a member of the "ENCAMPMENT HONOR SQUADRON." At the time of this printing the "ENCAMPMENT HONOR SQUADRON" is still a thing of the future, in so far as this encampment is concerned. But we are confident that the squadron receiving this title will have earned it. With exception to none, we are proud of each and every one of our squadrons and it's cadets at this, the 1959 SUMMER ENCAMPMENT.

HONOR CADETS

The most coveted award any single cadet can receive at Summer Encampment is the "HONOR CADET AWARD", given for the first time this year. This award, one of which is given to both male and female cadet, is presented only to a cadet attending his first year at Summer Encampment. It is based on recommendations of the TAC Officers, Sqn Commanders, instructors, Mess Officer, Range Officer Chaplain, and other general staff Officers, who, in turn base their decisions on the Cadet's character, co-operation, manners and willingness to work.
