Subject: Training Films

To : All Unit Commanders

1. Since the issuance of GM-104 relative to Training Films, certain changes have taken place, making it necessary that the original program for the use of these films, be revised.

2. At the present time there is a comprehensive Training Program being set up for CAP Cadets. In conjunction with this Program, training film and film strips will be made available.

3. Until the Program is announced there will be no film available for distribution from this Headquarters and the film that is now in circulation within various Wings will be returned to this Headquarters upon completion of the presently scheduled showings.

4. All Wing and Unit Commanders will be notified through channels just as soon as film and film strips can be made available. In the interim, it is suggested that the various Wings and Units continue with the showing of such film as may be available through local sources, the same as heretofore.
