
CAP FLIGHT OPERATIONS

1. Pursuant to instructions issued to this Headquarters by Hq., AAF, Civil Air Patrol flight operations, the cost of which is borne by the Army Air Forces, are specifically limited to the following:

- a. CAP Tow Target and Tracking Service, conducted under the provisions of Operations Directive No. 41.
- b. CAP Missing-Aircraft Search Service, conducted under the provisions of Operations Directive No. 44.
- c. Operation of AAF aircraft allocated to CAP Cadet Recruitment Program, conducted under the provisions of Operations Directive No. 40.

2. The foregoing paragraph is not to be construed as in any way precluding such CAP flight operations as Forest Patrol, Pipeline Patrol, Courier Missions, and miscellaneous services, performed at the request of and paid for with funds furnished by the Federal or any State Government of the United States, any sub-division, unit, department, or agency thereof, by the American Red Cross, or by any war industry.
