AAF LIAISON-TYPE AIRPLANES ALLOCATED TO
CAP AVIATION CADET RECRUITMENT PROGRAM

1. Effective 1 November 1944, paragraph 2 b, Operations Directive No. 40, this Headquarters, 1 July 1944, "AAF Liaison-Type Airplanes Allocated to CAP Aviation Cadet Recruitment Program", is hereby changed to read as follows:

"b. Under no circumstances will said airplanes be used for flight instruction purposes, nor will said airplanes be used in the performance of search missions except in cases of emergency when privately-owned CAP aircraft are not available for the performance of the Missing-Aircraft Search Service provided under Operations Directive No. 44, this Headquarters, 1 July 1944. In such emergency cases, said airplanes may, upon written authorization from National Headquarters, be used in the performance of said search missions as set forth in Change No. 1, Operations Directive No. 44, this date."
