I. DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD. -- Under the provisions of paragraph 8, Civil Air Patrol Regulation 35-4, the Distinguished Service Award is awarded to the following-named Officer:

SECOND LIEUTENANT LOUIS ROSENBLATT, CAP 411731, Florida Wing, distinguished himself in January 1943 by an act of heroism involving voluntary risk of life at Lantana Airport, Florida, while assigned to the Lantana Squadron, Civil Air Patrol. LIEUTENANT (then CORPORAL) ROSENBLATT, disregarding his own personal safety, removed a badly damaged bomb from the fuselage of a CAP aircraft that had crashed returning from an Anti-Submarine Patrol mission. This action averted complete destruction of a badly needed aircraft. The outstanding heroism and distinctive leadership of LIEUTENANT ROSENBLATT reflect great credit upon himself and the Civil Air Patrol.
