SUBJECT: Training Directive No. 35 and Preflight Study Manual

TO: All CAP Wing Commanders and AAF-CAP Liaison Officers

1. The reserve supplies of Training Directive No. 35, "CAP Ground and Preflight Training Program" and of the Preflight Study Manual for Civil Air Patrol Cadets carried by this headquarters have been completely exhausted. While an effort is being made to obtain funds for reprinting these publications, additional copies are urgently needed for immediate use.

2. It is important that existing stocks of these publications in possession of the Wings be used to best advantage and also that the new editions be distributed to all Wings simultaneously in time for the opening of the school term next fall.

3. In light of the foregoing, it is requested that each Wing Headquarters make a survey of its stock of these two publications and that the AAF-CAP Liaison Officers forward to this headquarters at once on government bill of lading all copies not actually needed to carry the cadet training program through the summer of this year.
