

INSTRUCTION SHEETS - PERSONNEL SECURITY QUESTIONNAIRES

1. The Office of the Provost Marshal advises that considerable difficulty and confusion have been encountered with poorly executed Personnel Security Questionnaires, due to ambiguities in the present instruction sheet (W.D., P.M.G.O.-ID FORMS 58 A), which accompanied said forms.

Effective immediately, the instructions set forth on the instruction sheet enclosed herewith (Instructions for Completing Personnel Security Questionnaire, W.D., P.M.G.O. -ID FORM NO. 58) will be adhered to in completing Personnel Security Questionnaires and all instruction sheets now attached to these forms will be destroyed.
