

CARRYING PASSENGERS IN CAP AIRCRAFT ASSIGNED TO COURIER SERVICE FOR AIR SERVICE SUB-DEPOTS.

1. Effective this date, no passengers will be carried in Civil Air Patrol aircraft while under orders in the performance of Military Courier missions for Air Service Sub-Depots, excepting such members of the Armed Forces of the United States as may be specifically authorized as passengers in such aircraft by the Commanding Officers of the Air Service Sub-Depots to which said aircraft are assigned.
