INTERIOR GUARD DUTY

1. General

As the Civil Air Patrol may from time to time in cases of emergency be called upon to assist in providing for the safety and security of airports, landing fields and other defense property, it is important that the members of the Patrol know and understand the fundamentals of Interior Guard Duty.

2. Text

War Department Basic Field Manual, Interior Guard Duty, FM 26-5, has been adopted as the text to be used for instruction in this subject.

3. Distribution of Text

Copies of this text will be distributed to units of the Civil Air Patrol on the basis of four copies per unit.


4. Requirement

All members of the Civil Air Patrol are required to take this course of instruction.

5. Instruction Procedure

It is recommended that the instructors selected to conduct this course be men with previous military training and experience. In many instances it may be possible to have this course handled by the instructor conducting the course in Infantry Drill Regulations covered by Training Directive No. 2.
