
Subject: Operations Directive No. 2—Display of Civil Air
Patrol Insignia on Aircraft

To: All Unit Commanders

1. The insignia authorized by the War Department for display on Civil Air Patrol aircraft is the basic insignia of the Patrol described in Operations Directive No. 2. This insignia consists of a blue disk with superimposed white triangle and with red three-blade propeller superimposed on the triangle.

2. The use of the letters "U.S." superimposed on the lower segment of the blue disk of the basic insignia is authorized for Civil Air Patrol shoulder insignia only and is not permitted for insignia displayed on aircraft.
