SUBJECT: Receipt of Radio Transmitter Crystals.

TO: All Wing Commanders.

1. Within a few days you will receive the number of transmitter crystals entered on the attached receipt. If previous reports from your Headquarters are accurate, you will have enough crystals so that one may be installed in the transmitter of each Army airplane which is assigned to you.

2. Upon receipt of the crystals, it is directed that you comply with the following instructions:

a. Distribute the crystals to the units in your command to which the Army airplanes are now assigned. Require the Commander of those units to install the crystals and return to you a receipt similar to the one attached to this letter.

b. If you do not have enough crystals so that one may be installed in each Army airplane assigned to you, inform the National Communications Officer immediately by wire, advising him of the number needed. Provided your wire checks with the figures filed by the National Operations Officer, additional crystals will be sent to you at once. Nevertheless, return the receipt without delay for the crystals you do have. Another receipt will be forwarded with any additional crystals.

c. When you have the information, complete the attached receipt.

(1) Enter the date.

(2) Enter the serial number of each airplane in which a crystal is installed.

(3) Sign the receipt. No one except a Wing Commander will sign this receipt or else an Officer who has been authorized by National Headquarters to act in his absence.

d. Retain one carbon copy and return the original receipt and the remaining carbons to the address indicated thereon.

3. Wing Commanders will keep the old crystals which came with the airplanes in their personal possession pending further instructions.
