Subject: Authorization for Promotions - CAP Coastal Patrols

To: All CAP Coastal Patrol Commanders

1. Reference: (a) General Memorandum No. 76, this Headquarters, 27 February 1943, subject: "Promotion of Coastal Patrol and Liaison Patrol Personnel"; (b) letter, this Headquarters 10 March, 1943, subject: "Policy of Promotions - CAP Coastal Patrols and Liaison Patrols".

2. Supplementing paragraph 3 reference (b), the number of promotions within or to the commissioned-officer grades, including the grade of Flight Officer, authorized per base is hereby increased by an additional four (4) promotions.

3. Particular attention is directed to the policy set forth in paragraph 2, reference (b).

4. Promotions to and within the commissioned grades are made by National Headquarters on recommendations of Base Commanders, each recommendation being considered separately and on its merits. It is important that recommendations be prepared in strict accordance with instructions set forth in paragraph 4, reference (b).
