

SHIRT COLLAR AND CAP INSIGNIA

1. All CAP commissioned officers and warrant officers are hereby authorized to wear rank insignia on the right side of the shirt collar and the silver CAP wings-and-propeller insignia on the left side of the shirt collar whenever the shirt is worn as the outer garment of the CAP uniform.

2. The CAP plain disk cap insignia is required to be worn on the garrison (overseas) cap by all personnel and on the service cap by all enlisted personnel. The CAP wreathed disk cap insignia is required to be worn on the service cap by all warrant and flight officers. The CAP winged cap insignia is required to be worn on the service cap by all commissioned officers.
