Subject: Replacement of Uniform Sholder Straps (All Personnel)


To: All Unit Commanders

1. Enclosed is color sample known as Cable No. 14906, Textile Color Card Association (Army). This color must be matched and material should be of flannel or other suitable material that will not fade.

2. This red material is to be used to cover or replace the standard shoulder loop or straps now attached to all uniforms. The red shoulder strap is now official on all uniforms, including leather jacket, for all personnel of Civil Air Patrol.

3. Instructions. Remove present shoulder straps and replace with above-mentioned red flannel color straps, or sew red flannel strap to present shoulder strap. If the present shoulder strap is replaced with new red strap, the new strap may be attached to the shirt at the square end by either snaps or hoods and eyes.
