Subject: Penalty Privilege (Franking Privilege)

To: All Wing Commanders

1. By special arrangement with the Post Office Department, the penalty privilege may henceforth be used by all Civil Air Patrol Squadron Commanders who have been commissioned by National Headquarters, Civil Air Patrol. This is the same privilege previously extended to CAP Regional, Wing and Group Commanders by GM-19, dated 15 May 1942, and is limited to the provisions specified and procedures prescribed in GM-19.

2. Any such CAP commanders may use either the official OCD or OEM envelopes and labels or the official War Department envelopes and labels.

3. The quarterly reports required in paragraph 8 of GM-19 need not be submitted, although each unit commander should be prepared to submit, upon request, an estimate of material mailed by him under the penalty privilege.
