## SUMMARY NARRATIVE OF MAJOR ACTIVITIES

*2020 began with a series of stressful events beginning with a tragic SAR Mission turning into a recovery effort, a highly successful Air Force Operations Evaluation, Staff Assisted Visit, hosting the Region Commander's Call and Tsunami Warning Mission orientation in January; Uncle Billy Enoka's final flight on 22 February and subsequent memorial services. The wing lost Lt Col Enoka, Wing Aircraft Maintenance Officer and Cadet Glider Program Coordinator passed away when a civilian tow plane he was a passenger in crashed during takeoff. With permission from the family, Hawaii Wing established a Cadet Flight Scholarship in his name.*

*The COVID-19 pandemic hit and the Wing halted all in person training, meetings, and events beginning in mid-March. Hawaii Wing was able to quickly adapt to online - virtual - meetings and continued pressing forward with training. Of significance was the weekly Wing Director's Briefs open to all members, which served to build camaraderie and foster open discussions keeping all participating members and squadrons well informed. Major accomplishments include making contact and beginning a relationship with FEMA Region IX to explore training opportunities and an Annual Mission Assignment for Pre-Event Aerial Photography, integrating Aerospace Education into Cadet Program events, establishing a new Wing Website, and moving the Wing towards a consolidated training and education platform that will foster continuity with future command and staff.*

*Hawaii Wing displayed great resiliency throughout the year adapting to challenges the pandemic presented with innovative solutions. Many unsung heroes pushed the wing forward, among which are the following members who earned Of The Year wing awards.*

## **Chapter I OPERATIONS**

### **Search and Rescue**

HAWAII WING PARTICIPATED IN 19 SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATIONS IN 2020. INCIDENT COMMANDERS COORDINATED WITH LOCAL SQUADRONS TO STAFF MISSIONS APPROPRIATELY. SEARCH AND RESCUE EFFORTS BEGAN IN JANUARY WHEN WE WERE CALLED UPON TO ASSIST LOCATING A MISSING HELICOPTER ON KAUAI. CREWS REPORTED AND PERFORMED AS WE TRAINED AND FLEW ABOVE THE CLOUD COVER AT ABOUT 4000' AGL. THE HELICOPTER WAS LOCATED ON THE FIRST SORTIE AND COORDINATES RELAYED TO RESPONDERS ON THE GROUND. WHILE THE MISSION TURNED OUT TO BE A RECOVERY, CREWS WERE COMMENDED BY LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AND FIRE RESCUE TEAMS FOR QUICKLY BRINGING CLOSURE TO FAMILIES. LT COL WILLIAM ENOKA WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN USING HIS EXPERIENCE AND KNOWLEDGE OF THE AREA TO PLAN THE SORTIE AND DIRECT THE CREW. THE LOSS OF A BELOVED AVIATOR IN THE SMALL ISLAND COMMUNITY SHOOK KAUAI AND GAVE US A GOOD LESSON IN CISM RESPONSE. WE ALSO SUPPORTED 8 REAL WORLD SAR/ELT SEARCHES FOR THE COAST GUARD ON FOUR ISLANDS THAT RESULTED IN 7 FINDS, ONE WAS CANCELLED WHEN THE SIGNAL STOPPED REPORTING BEFORE WE LOCATED IT.

### **Disaster Response**

HAWAII WING PARTICIPATED IN DISASTER RELIEF OPERATIONS IN 2020. THE WING STAFF COORDINATED WITH THE SQUADRONS TO STAFF MISSIONS. DISASTER RELIEF EFFORTS FOCUSED ON A WING-WIDE COMMUNICATIONS TRAINING, AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY TRAINING, HURRICANE DOUGLAS AND TSUNAMI WARNING. TRANSPORTATION OF PPE TO MAUI IN SUPPORT OF COVID-19 MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS. CONDUCTED VIRTUAL TRAINING TO PREPARE FOR THE HURRICANE SEASON.

### **Homeland Security**

HAWAII WING WAS PRESENTED WITH THE PACIFIC REGION 2020 HOMELAND DEFENSE/HOMELAND SECURITY AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN HOMELAND DEFENSE AND HOMELAND SECURITY

HAWAII WING HAD AN ACTIVE YEAR IN HOMELAND SECURITY EXANDING MISSIONS TO INCLUDE TWO B-13 MISSIONS FUNDED BY THE US NAVY IN SUPPORT OF THE PACIFIC MISSILE RANGE FACILITY, FLYING RADAR TARGET AIR DEFENSE MISSIONS WITH A TOTAL OF 15 SORTIES AND 35.3 HOURS.

HAWAII WING CONTINUED SUPPRT OF THE HAWAII AIR NATIONAL GUARD AND USAF WITH SEVEN FIGHTER INTERCEPT AIR DEFENSE MISSIONS FLYING 46 HOURS OVER 14 SORTIES UNDER THE A-18 MISSION SYMBOL.

## **Chapter II AEROSPACE EDUCATION**

### **Internal Aerospace Education**

THE FOCUS OF THE INTERNAL AEROSPACE PROGRAM IN 2020 IN HAWAII WING WAS ON STEM KITS, ORIENTATION FLIGHTS, AEROSPACE EDUCATION EXCELLENCE, RECRUITING AEMS, AND SUPPORTING AEOS. ADDITIONALLY, 17 SENIOR MEMBERS OF THE WING EARNED THE BRIGADIER GENERAL CHUCK YEAGER AWARD IN 2020. ADVANCED STEM BADGES WERE AWARDED TO TWO CADETS WHO WERE BROTHERS. COVID LIMITATIONS LIMITED MUCH OF THE IN-PERSON TRAINING. SIMULATED UAS TRAINING AND REDBIRD TD FLIGHT SIMULATOR TRAINING WAS CONDUCTED. VIRTUAL AND SOCIALLY-DISTANCED ROCKETRY EVENTS WERE USED AS WORK-UPS FOR EVENTUAL IN-PERSON WING EVENTS. LIVE VIRTUAL TOUR OF THE PEARL HARBOR AVIATION MUSEUM WITH INTERACTIVE PHYSICS OF FLIGHT LESSONS.

### **External Aerospace Education**

EXTERNAL AEROSPACE EDUCATION EFFORTS IN HAWAII WING FOR 2020 WAS FOCUSED ON OUTREACH TO SCHOOLS AND TEACHERS. PARTNERSHIPS WERE PURSUED WITH ORGANIZATIONS THAT SHARE AN INTEREST IN AVIATION AND AEROSPACE.

## **Chapter III CADET PROGRAMS**

### **Cadet Programs**

CADET PROGRAMS IN HAWAII WING WORKED WITH THE SQUADRONS TO SUPPORT A FULL RANGE OF ACTIVITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR CADETS INCLUDING A PLANNED ENCAMPMENT. HAWAII WING PROVIDED 39 GLIDER ORIENTATION FLIGHTS OUT OF DILLINGHAM AIRFIELD AND 474.2 POWERED ORIENTATION FLIGHT HOURS FOR CADETS. EIGHTY-EIGHT NEW MEMBERS WERE SIGNED-UP WITH A GOAL TO INCREASE FEMALE MEMBERSHIP FROM 25% TO 35% BY THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR. AS THE WING MOVED INTO COVID RESTRICTIONS, SQUADRONS PROVIDED THEIR TRAINING PLANS FOR VIRTUAL AND SOCIALLY-DISTANCED TRAINING.

THE WING AWARDED 26 MITCHELLS, 7 EARHARTS, 1 EAKER, 21 WRIGHT, 29 INITIAL ORIENTATION FLIGHTS CERTIFICATES. VIRTUAL OPEN HOUSES WERE CONDUCTED AT THE SQUADRON AND WING LEVELS. FOUR QUALITY CADET UNIT AWARDS WERE AWARDED TO ST LOUIS HI-077, WHEELER HI-009, KONA HI-060, AND MAUI HI-057 SQUADRONS. SQUADRON OF MERIT WAS AWARDED TO ST LOUIS HI-077. SQUADRONS FOUND IT NECESSARY TO BE CREATIVE IN ENGAGING THE CADETS. WHEELER COMPOSITE, AWARDED 2019 SQUADRON OF MERIT, IS AN EXCELLENT EXAMPLE OF THE HAWAII WING SQUADRON'S CREATIVITY. THEY ESTABLISHED A MENTORSHIP PROGRAM WITH WEEKLY CHECK-INS AND WEEKLY MENTORING, BROUGHT IN GUEST PT INSTRUCTORS TO LEAD FITNESS SESSIONS, TALK ABOUT MILITARY CAREERS AND

HEALTHY DIETS, THEY HELD A 10-WEEK AF/CAP ZOOM TRIVIA CONTEST AND A T-SHIRT DESIGN CONTEST, HELD ON-LINE PROMOTION CEREMONIES, AND DISTRIBUTED CHRISTMAS GIFT CARDS.

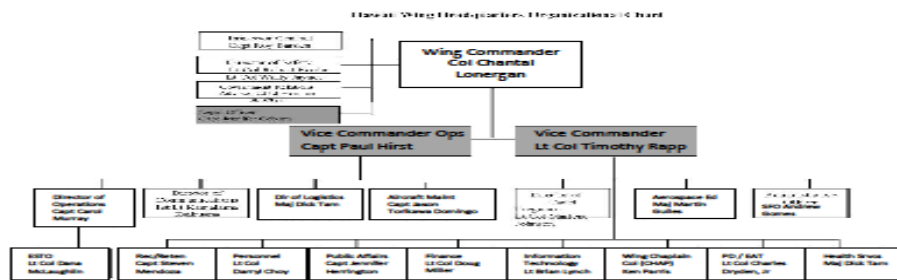

CO leak detected from cracked muffler. Noted by review that the pilot noticed popping sounds from the engine when engine retarded to idle before flight, but elected to proceed with the sortie without knowing what caused the noise; that was not explored during the review. No corrective action offered by wing commander; region commander followed up with comment that there should be training but no indication that it was followed up on. Review officer had not completed mishap review training and did not use the mishap review template.
