Nebraska Wing Cadet Programs 2020 in Review

January

Established Wing Goals for 2020

- **Recruiting:** Increase total number of cadets in Nebraska Wing by 10% compared to 1 January 2020 numbers.
- **Training:** All Nebraska Wing Squadrons with cadets, have at least two senior members current in the Training Leaders of Cadets course.
- **Quality:** Increase number of squadron Cadet Quality Unit Award (CQUA) winners from 3 in 2018-2019 to 4 units in the 2019-2020 timeframe.
- **Flying:** At least 80% of the cadets in the wing have participated in at least one orientation flight.
- **Aerospace:** At least five units in the wing earn the Aerospace Education Excellence (AEX) Award for the 2019-2020 timeframe.
- **Retention:** Wing retains at least 50% of the first year cadets that joined in 2019.
- **Emergency Services:** At least 60% of the wing's cadets have GES certification
- **Training:** Conduct at least three wing-level cadet professional development classes.

TLC Basic Course in Lincoln Nebraska – 14 graduates
