## SUMMARY NARRATIVE OF MAJOR ACTIVITIES

#### Search and Rescue

NEBRASKA WING CONDUCTED SEARCH AND RESCUE TRAINING IN 2018 WITH AN AIR FORCE EVALUATION COMPLETED AS WELL. TWO MISSIONS WERE TASKED TO NEBRASKA WING PERSONNEL BY AFRCC, ONE ON 10 SEPT 18 FOR AN ELT AROUND THE WAHOO AIRPORT AND THE OTHER ON 4 JULY 18 FOR AN EPIRB TRANSMITTING ON 406/121.5. THIS RESULTED IN A NON-DISTRESS FIND FOR NEBRASKA WING.

NEBRASKA WING MEMBERS WERE ALSO CALLED OUT ON TWO CORPORATE MISSIONS, THE FIRST ON 9-19 MAY 18, LOOKING FOR AN ATV RIDER, THE SECOND WAS LONG TERM AERIAL FIRE WATCH FROM 1 JAN - 29 SEPT 18.
